- 3) Your short-term educational goals (next 3-5 years) and long-term career goals (5+years)
  - a. What made you choose this educational path?
  - b. Why are you interested in this training or field of study?
  - c. Where do you see yourself after your college education?
- 4) Tell us about your high school experience.
  - a. How have you served your community as a volunteer?
  - b. Have you held a job? If so, what jobs have you held?
  - c. Have you been recognized for academic accomplishments and achievement?
  - d. Have you taken college or STEM courses or had on the job training?
- 5) How does your support system from home make you a better candidate to be successful in college or vocational training?
  - a. Who has most influenced you in your life?
  - b. Does your family encourage you in your educational future?
